NTOMBISPORT AWARD FOR RESEARCH IN AFRICAN WOMEN AND GIRLS IN SPORT

To recognise and enhance research on the health and welfare of African women and girls in sport, by African women sports science researchers. The award also seeks to provide female African sports science researchers with opportunities to be mentored by fellow researchers of African women and girls in sport. The award consists of funds to be used for living expenses by the recipient.

Value of award

\$600

Tenure

The tenure of the award is one year and is ONCE-OFF

Eligibility criteria

This award is given to a female Zimbabwean university student conducting sports science research in African women and girls in sport. This research should be in fulfilment of the requirements of their undergraduate or postgraduate degree. The recipient should be conducting research in areas of sports science such as, but not limited to, physiotherapy, sports injuries, physical activity, physiology, nutrition, performance, recovery, and psychology. The student must be registered as a student at a Zimbabwean university.

Selection criteria

- i. Scientific excellence of the research project.
- ii. Relevance of research project to African women and girls in sport.
- iii. Quality of application.
- iv. Ability to communicate and promote sports science.

Application procedure

Applicants must submit:

- i. Abridged CV with contactable references (≤ 3 pages Arial 11 or Times New Roman 12).
- ii. Certified copies of academic transcripts. **Please do not attach certificates.**
- iii. Proof of registration as a student at a Zimbabwean University.
- iv. Project proposal with the following:
 - a) Title
 - b) Research timeline including motivation from research supervisor demonstrating research progress and completion timelines (max 1000 characters).
 - c) Project summary (max 1000 characters)
 - d) Project methodology summary (max 2000 characters)
 - e) Intended research participants (max 1000 characters)
 - f) Expected research outcomes (max 1000 characters)
 - g) Benefits to the welfare of female African athletes (max 1000 characters)
 - h) Proof of ethical approval/submission from/to relevant institutional review board(s). If ethical approval is not required, the applicant must explain why (max 1000 characters).



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Applications submitted without the required information and supporting documents as specified will not be considered.

Deadline for application

All applications should be submitted by **midnight (SAST), 15th June 2022.**
